Since the first time meeting my buddy, our relationship has bloomed. A year ago, I would not even dare to think about how comfortable my buddy could become, I was merely focused on getting to understand and know him; now, his face lights up when he sees my car on his street; he describes the challenges he faces due to his disability, and he tells me about his biggest aspirations in life. The tangible progress my buddy has made through this mentorship has not only been beneficial to him, but it has also taught me the
